





• All three organizations:

- are formed by local jurisdictions adopting a standard mutual aid agreement
- coordinate each particular discipline during requests for legitimate mutual aid
- have a Governing Board of Directors
- similarly organized
- primarily coordinate local assets; however, each owns its own assets
- are part of the Illinois Terrorism Task Force
- are in various stages of adopting MOUs between all three

At its discretion, provide support of equipment owned by ILEAS when requested by IPWMAN	At its discretion, provide support of equipment owned by MABAS when requested by ILEAS	Make positions available on special teams from both MABAS and IPWMAN including specific training pursuant to the discretion of each party
